

Tom Riley was awarded the 2011 Alumni Achievement Award from the Fulton Colleges Board of Associates. Riley graduated in 1993 from Westminster College. He later attended law school at Washington & Lee University and served as a law-clerk for the Missouri Supreme Court before returning to Fulton to practice law with Riley & Dunlap, P.C. Riley's professional achievements include attaining the highest possible (AV) peer-review rating from other lawyers and successfully pursuing cases from federal trial courts to the Missouri Supreme Court. Riley was also recognized for civic and charitable contributions including the establishment of the downtown revitalization committee when serving as President of the Chamber of Commerce, quadrupling the funds of Fulton Area Development Committee as Chairman of the Board, and, when serving as President, establishing the Fulton Colleges Board of Associates itself as a charitable nonprofit corporation.
